Stay safe: Keep clearance around SMUD equipment



Our top priorities are providing safe, reliable service, at low rates. To do this, we routinely inspect our electrical equipment, and our crew need clear access at all times.

To ensure proper access, the following are legally required:

- An 8-foot clearance in front of transformers a green utility box in a front or side yard.
- A 3-foot clearance around utility poles.
